Lucas Oil Stadium – Indianapolis, IN

Friday, November 4

7:00 - 7:45 AM CDST	Arrive at DGS with overnight bags and personal effects (please place in Ensemble Room)
1:30 PM	Rehearsal begins 7 th period with stretching in stadium, normal warm-up and cold run
3:30 PM	Final Run - Rehearsal Ends –Pack trailer and rental truck
4:00 PM	Dinner in Band Hallway (provided by band boosters)
4:45 PM	Load Busses 1 – 3 with personal luggage and Instruments (pre-assigned by a sign-up list) (mellos, baritones, tenor saxes in rental truck – battery split between truck & mini-bus)
5:15 PM	Depart for Indianapolis
10:00 PM EDST	Check-in at Hotel (instruments stay in rental truck/mini-bus/all others & bari saxes into hotel)
	Uniforms unloaded and taken to Hotel Rooms individually, hat boxes stay on busses
11:00 PM	Curfew – all students in their assigned rooms
11:15 PM	Lights out – Sleep is essential for a great performance

5:30 AM	Wake-up calls - plan showers (some at night) so that all can eat, shower and change into full uniform in the allotted time
6:00 AM	Breakfast at the Hotel
6:45 AM	Load Busses in full uniform, minus hats
7:00 AM	Depart for Lucas Oil Stadium
7:30 AM	Arrive at South Lot (Gate 10 off of McCarthy Street)
	Unload all equipment & instruments, grab hats, prop frames, yellow fleeces
8:00 AM	Move to South Tunnel
8:05 AM	Enter South-West Tunnel and proceed to Physical Warm-up including stretching
8:15 AM	Physical Warm-up in Area B (15 minutes)
	Pit Warm-up in Area B (30 minutes)
8:30 AM	Music Warm-up in Area A (30 minutes) – Water and restrooms available
8:50 AM	Pit Report Time
9:05 AM	Band Report Time
9:15 AM	MARCHING MUSTANG PERFORMANCE TIME

Saturday, November 5 (continued)

9:30 AM	Move back to South Parking lot, stay in uniform, pack hats, equipment and instruments
10:30 AM	Travel back to hotel to change out of uniform, check-out, pack rolling uniform cases
12:00 PM	Travel to local food court for lunch
1:30 PM	Travel back to Stadium to watch remaining bands and prelim awards
2:00 PM	Enjoy the performances of remaining bands (be sure to see Avon at 4:00pm)
4:15 PM	Exhibition Performance by ISU, Drum Majors, Lauren & Deven report to tunnel
4:30 PM	Prelim Awards
4:45 PM	Exit South Gate and meet in the parking lot (same place where the busses were parked)
5:00 PM	Walk together to busses (further down the block at the E-Z lot)
5:30 PM	Load Busses - Depart Indianapolis – Dinner en route

Lucas Oil Stadium Safety Guidelines

From a safety and security perspective, fans should observe the following:

- Students, parents, directors and fans should be advised that nothing larger than a small personal handbag, subject to inspection, will be permitted inside the Stadium (through the main gates).
- Performance-related equipment will be permitted in, but only through the routine flow of the event.
- Items specifically prohibited inside the Stadium are listed below. Failure to comply with these requirements may result in denial of admission to the stadium.
- Fans are advised to arrive early to avoid congestion at the gates. Gates and gate open times are listed on the daily schedule contained in your final packet and are published on www.musicforall.org.
- Fans and participants may not bring the following items into the Stadium:
 - Video and Audio Recorders
 - Bottles, Cans, Liquor containers
 - Food and Beverages – coolers
 - Bags or large purses
 - Backpacks
 - Balloons (helium)
 - Fanny packs
 - Air horns
 - Missile-like objects
- Bands of America strictly prohibits the presence of weapons on Lucas Oil Stadium property during the event
- Bands of America will provide a qualified medical staff, and they will be located on the field and concourse for any major problems that might arise. Find the nearest uniformed Lucas Oil Stadium staff member, a BOA volunteer or BOA staff member for immediate assistance
