Marching Band 2015-2016

To-date, 127 students have made some amount of financial commitment to join the Marching Mustangs for the new season, plus 1 student who received a marching band scholarship but submitted no payment of their own. There are currently 37 incoming freshman and 8 new (non-freshman) members that have submitted at least one payment.

No payment has been received from 7 former students (6 color guard, and 1 band). Mr. Roselieb also has two additional students on his attendance roster, 1 incoming freshman, and 1 non-freshman, however no paperwork or payment has been submitted.

Individual emails continue to be sent out in an attempt to get past due forms and payments submitted. A checklist itemizing what is missing from each student will be included in the applicable student's folders that will be distributed at the parent social night.

A color guard roster has still not been provided.

The date for refunds to be granted has passed, however, the roster my still fluctuate a bit especially since some members have only submitted a \$50 intent deposit.
