



## **Home Football Game - SENIOR NIGHT – August 31, 2018**

- 5:00 PM Students report to band room, get uniforms from loft and select a space to change (options below). **No one will change in the band room.** After changing, return to band room and neatly place hat boxes, hangers, etc. on a chair in your section.
- Changing Rooms:** Color Guard - B124 Ladies - Choir Room Gentlemen - Bathrooms/Locker Rooms
- 5:30 PM Students line up in parade formation on band room driveway and march out to practice field.
- 5:40 PM Stretching and Basics
- 6:00 PM Music Warm-Up/Rehearsal for Halftime Performance
- 6:40 PM Pre-Game Rehearsal - Dance Team Run-Through & national Anthem
- 7:10 PM Formation on Track (North Endzone) - Seniors will line up near the South side of the front sideline for Senior Night.
- 7:25 PM Students line up in pre-game formation after teams exit field. Pre-Game Begins: Fillies Tune - Fight Song - National Anthem - Tunnel/Team Run-On. (3 minutes remaining on game clock)
- 7:30 PM Return to stands and play cheers during the 1st half. With 5 min remaining in the 2nd Quarter, band moves to track behind South Endzone for show warm-up.
- 8:30 PM Halftime Performance
- 8:40 PM Return to stands - play stand tunes for the remainder of the game.
- 9:45 PM Game ends - students return to band room, change in assigned spaces, and put away all equipment.

### **NOTES:**

- Many of the times on this schedule are estimated guesses based on how quick or slow the football game progresses.
- Students are not allowed to eat in uniform. Please make sure that every student comes to a football game having already eaten a healthy dinner that will get them through the game.
- Students should wear the uniform with pride and become an ambassador to the school.
