



## What Does Your Band Program Have to Offer You?

**Concert Band** - All incoming Freshmen students are placed in Concert Band to begin the registration process. This is our entry level band course at South High School. Upon the completion of an audition (these have already begun at your middle school) you may be placed in a different band after you meet your counselors again at the end of January. These include our upper level ensembles: Symphonic Band, Wind Symphony, and Wind Ensemble. Membership in these bands is determined by your ability level (through the audition process) and the available instrumentation in each group. The final results of this process will be sent to your 8<sup>th</sup> grade band directors in March. The exciting part is that every band student controls their own destiny throughout the high school experience. Students re-audition every year to determine band placement for the following school year.

**Marching Mustangs** – The Marching Mustangs are a voluntary organization that is open to any band student. Membership will include a number of exciting competitions including our very own *Marching Mustang Music Bowl*, football games, the Downers Grove July 4<sup>th</sup> Parade, summer band camp, and a weekend overnight trip to one of our Fall competitions. **Please attend our information/recruitment meeting scheduled for Monday, March 12, 2018, at 7:00 pm** in the auditorium to find out more about the exciting and rewarding season coming up this fall.

**Jazz Band** – For those interested in learning and performing jazz music, we offer 3 different jazz groups. Jazz Ensemble, Jazz Lab Band, and Jazz Workshop meet daily at 7 am, before school for full credit. Auditions will take place for these groups during the first week of classes next fall during the early bird class time from 7-7:50 am. Audition music will be available from your 8<sup>th</sup> grade director this coming spring. Please have your counselor add jazz to your course schedule for interested jazz students.

**Additional Extra-curricular Activities** – Our program offers several other groups that meet during the evening for interested students. These include the Winter Guard, Percussion Ensemble, the Pep Band, and various small chamber groups. These groups are instructed by our private teaching faculty and marching band staff. Membership is open to all of these groups for everyone.
