2019 Marching Mustangs

First Competition completed at Lake Park - huge thanks to everyone, big collective effort for us to be successful. 2nd in class after prelims, 3rd Overall after finals - historically the highest placement for the Marching Mustangs!

Rehearsal happening right now - next rehearsal is Wednesday night 6-9, Friday 3:30-5, and then VJ Andrew on Saturday - going up against the top bands in the state.

One performance on Saturday. We are classified as AA due to band size, we will compete AAA on Saturday, as practice for ISU.

Music Bowl

New trophies are ordered. Final roster of the participating bands needed to make the participation plaques.

Currently deciding who will do score tabulation - Craig Roselieb is unavailable this year. Rolando Cervantes has assisted Craig in the past and could be trained (free option) - I can reach out to a local contest runner that does scoring, we would have to pay him a fee.

Concert Band

Bands are playing well to start the year. Challenging literature for all 4 levels.

V. President (Gretchen Shearer):

Scholarships

16 applications received for the Don Wilson Scholarship. Five seniors applied for private lesson scholarships and four applicants were awarded two scholarships based on the strength of their applications.

Car wash June 15, 2019

Car wash made \$1289.00. Thank you to John Ford, Barbara Abarro and Mr. and Mrs. Hewawissa for supervising. Next car wash is September 15, 2019.

<u>Audit</u>

Student accounts from 2017-2018 need to be audited. The booster checking account for 2017-2018 was not initially audited, however, Mr. Williams still wants us to audit the account. Gretchen will try to get those audits done by the end of the year and by then the 2018-2019 accounts will be ready to be audited.

Charms

We renewed Charms subscription for one year to use for student accounts. Mr. Hensel has created a master excel spreadsheet that can be used for emailing.

<u>Budget meeting</u> (Paraphrased from the email sent to board on May 13, 2019) Jamie Nolan and I (Gretchen Shearer) met with Mr. Hensel and Mr. Brooks in May. Jamie doesn't have the final numbers yet for the 2018-2019 season. Marching Band costs appear to have ended in the black, even though props were over budget. It looks like we will have some retained earnings (budget surplus) from the 2018-2019 season, but we don't know the final number yet.

The bass clarinet purchase was approved by the board, if there was funding in the budget. There is \$62,677.59 in the combined Music Bowl funds from 2016. 2017 and 2018. If we

reserve \$27,500 for the 2019-2020 marching band budget and \$27,500 for the 2020-2021 budget, that leaves \$7677.59. Since this was identified by the directors as a critical need, I proposed that we use this \$7677 surplus to cover (mostly) the clarinet. There were no objections to this after it sent to the board via email.

The two Marimbas had already been ordered and delivered and the Shakos have been ordered. Since it would cost us \$3,000 to return the marimbas (almost a third of the cost), the directors have talked to the school administration and the school is offering to cover these items for now as a zero interest loan to be repaid after the Music Bowl next year (~\$6200 for the Shakos and \$9,484 for the marimbas).

Some components of the sound system have been purchased, but further spending on this has been suspended. The cost of the sound system so far is about \$9823.98 which will likely be covered (hopefully for the most part) with the budget surplus.

The directors have made adjustments to the 2019 Marching Band budget, so it is balanced. The outstanding costs are the panels for the uniforms, extra cost for the overnight trip, senior dinner (which can be turned back into a senior breakfast) and possibly costs for the props. The directors are working on this and we are working adding some fundraisers. Any budget deficit from next year will have to come out of the Music Bowl reserves for 2020.

The slate for Executive Board was presented and voted on with challenge.
